2. Paul defends his integrity

- a) Reverence for the Lord (2 Cor 5:11)
- b) Concern for the Church (1 Cor 1:10)
- c) Devotion to the Truth (2 Cor 5:13)
- d) Gratitude for Christ's love (2 Cor 5:14)
- e) Desire for Righteousness (1 Cor 10:31-11;1)
- f) Burden for the Lost (2 Cor 5:16)

3. Paul reveals his humility

- a) An unwillingness to compare oneself with others (2 Cor 10:12)
- b) A willingness to minister within limits (2 Cor 10:13)
- c) An unwillingness to take credit for others' labours (2 Cor 10:14-15)
- d) A willingness to seek only the Lord's glory (1 Cor 1:26-29)
- e) An unwillingness to pursue anything but eternal commendation (2 Cor 10:18)
