**Topic: Who Will Feed Me?**

Scripture text: 2 Kings 4:42-44

1. There was a famine in the land and the people were in need of food. Baalshalisha brought twenty loaves of barley and some corn. Although it was little in quantity, he brought the firstfruits of his harvest, representing the best of what he had. Even though Elisha's server doubted that it was sufficient to feed a hundred men, Elisha obeyed God's commandment by insisting that the food be distributed. God performed a miracle and provided abundantly for the men, even with leftovers. When God is with us, the little that we have will be sufficient for us and we will have no lack as long as we seek first the kingdom of God. God has glorified Himself by providing for His missionaries for His work and His will to be done.

2. Jesus Christ is the Bread of Life who will provide us with both physical and spiritual food. To be under the providential care of God, men have to partake of the Bread of life by believing and receiving Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Saviour. When their sins are cleansed, they will experience spiritual birth and eternal life.

3. Every Christian needs to be fed the Word of God daily to grow in the grace and knowledge of God's Word. It is the milk and meat for his soul. Daily Christian living should involve reading God's Word (God speaking to you) and praying (you speaking to God). The Lord has already provided all that we need to be fed spiritually – the Bible and the Holy Spirit. Let us hunger and thirst after the Word of God and to live by it.
