Topic: A Study of Titus - Dealing with Falsehood

Text: Titus 1:10-16

1. Many people in the world use social media to promote falsehood and lies. There are also a lot of Bible teachings on the internet. However, if we are not careful, we may be taken in by the false teachers and start propagating false doctrines. In the past, in the church of Crete, there were also many false teachers who tried to deceive the congregation.
2. These false teachers appear to be legitimate because they were of the circumcision. This meant that they were Jews, who were well versed in Scripture. However, they refused to submit to the authority of God's Word and their words did not build up God's people. Besides that, they lived sinful lives which brought down the name of God. The Pharisees came up with their own man-made traditions and appeared to be very spiritual. But they were so far from God in their hearts. Therefore, we must learn to be wise and evaluate the content and conduct of the Bible teachers according to God's standard.
3. The consequence of letting these false teachers go on are disastrous. They will make a shipwreck of the spiritual lives of entire families. Many will be stumbled by their teachings. Therefore, it is most necessary to rebuke these false teachers sharply. Such rebukes must be accurate from the Bible and direct at the individual.
4. Take heed and be very careful of the videos you watch on YouTube and the articles you read online. Be discerning and apply your heart unto wisdom. Never let your guard down and don't be taken in by the gift of the gab.
