Topic: A Study of Titus - Sound Women

Text: Titus 2:3-5

1. Every woman in the church is important because everyone has a role to play in the Body of Christ. The beginning of sound women is being grounded in the doctrine of God's Word. They do not despise doctrinal teaching but they know clearly from God's Word what to do and why they do it. Women who approach God's Word with such seriousness will spur even men to do even better.
2. A woman who is sound in the faith will produce holy conduct (v3). Such a woman is not driven by the fashions of the world, ambitions, or worldly speech. Her words, whether it be spoken or written, are not false accusations. Her lifestyle is also proper and she does not compromise.
3. If a woman has such holy conduct, then she will be a teacher of good things. She can teach her children and encourage others in the church to do likewise. The aged women are especially commanded to be godly examples and to lead and guide the younger women (v4). She will teach them to be sober in terms of their thinking and judgment so that everything is guided by God's Word. Those who are married should also teach the younger women to live purely and righteously in their home. Her chief priority and ambition is in the home. Her life shows what it means to love her children and submit to her husband.
4. When the women in the church don't behave in such a way, the word of God will be blasphemed (v5). Others will be stumbled and this may destroy the testimony of the church.
