Topic: Easter Combined Baptismal Service- Which Resurrection?

Text: Revelation 20:4-6

1. All those who believe in Christ and have truly repented of their sins will have the hope in Christ. Revelation 20:4-6 explain to us that not only the believers will be resurrected but everyone will also be resurrected. There are 2 resurrections; those who are not resurrected in the 1<sup>st</sup> resurrection will be resurrected in the 2<sup>nd</sup> resurrection.
2. The 1<sup>st</sup> resurrection is also called as the resurrection unto life. Those who are found in this resurrection are the tribulation saints who died in their faith (Rev 20:4) as well as other believers who truly believe in Christ as their Lord and Saviour. All believers are in the 1st resurrection who will receive a glorified body and have eternal life with the Lord.
3. The 2<sup>nd</sup> resurrection is called the resurrection unto death. Those who are found in this resurrection are the ones that do not believe in Christ and have not repented of their sin. They will face the judgment of God and will be sentenced into the lake of fire, which is the eternal death. This is their just punishment.
