Message Topic: Unity Among God's People

Scripture Text: Colossians 3: 15-17

- 1. Unity of believers in the local church is given by God and we must defend and protect and cherish it. However, often times we can ruin this unity from the Lord by our selfish acts and words.
- 2. We have a common peace given to us by God (v.15). This peace is from the Lord and is to rule in our hearts. We can ruin the unity of the church when the peace of God is not controlling us.
- 3. We have a common Word of God that should dwell in us (v.16). This will enable us to help, admonish and rejoice with one another.
- 4. We have also a common deed that we do all things to glorify the Lord Jesus Christ (v.17). In this way, we cause others to see Jesus Christ in our lives and to believe in Him.
- 5. With the common peace, common Word and common deed among Christians, it ought to lead us to unity in the Lord Jesus Christ.
