Message Topic: Risen Christ and Me

Scripture Text: Romans 8: 34

- 1. The question is asked in Rom 8:34 "Who is he that condemn us?". In reality, all are condemned and come short of the glory of God for all have sinned. However, we who believe in Jesus Christ are now no more condemned as Jesus took away all our sins.
- Satan will always be there to condemn us just as he did to Job and Zechariah recorded in the O.T.
 Satan can accuse us of our many sins but remember that the Lord Jesus Christ has forgiven all our sins past, present and future.
- 3. No one can condemn us because it is Jesus who died for us. He is the perfect Lamb of God. He is the Anointed One of God. Jesus' death is not weakness but power and victory.
- 4. No one can condemn us because it is Jesus who rose again for us. His resurrection is the sign of God's approval of his sacrificial death for us.
- 5. No one can condemn us because it is Jesus who intercedes for us seated at the right hand of God. Our salvation is complete and Jesus is now highly exalted. He is with us to hear our prayers.
