Message Topic: **Eternal Deed**Scripture Text: Revelation 4:1-11

- 1. Everything we do on earth has a last day except for one action. Worship of God is the one deed that we will do eternally. Hence, we should improve on our worship now on earth with more zeal and desire for the Lord and the Lord's Day worship service.
- 2. In v.1-3, the Bible tells that our worship will be performed in front of God. God is described as brilliant, glorious and magnificence. With the rainbow at His throne, God reminds us that He is a covenant keeping God.
- 3. In v.4-5, the 24 elders who are seated before God in position of leadership is a representation of all the believers in Heaven. Believers are clothed in white raiment signifying all our sins are washed away by the cleansing power of the blood of Jesus Christ. In this description, we see God the Father and the Holy Spirit being worshipped (God the Son will be described in chapter 5). Lightning and thunders are seen which show that God is awesome in His power.
- 4. In v.6-9, we see the 4 beasts which represent the entire angel beings. They are perpetually worshiping God day and night.
- 5. In v.10-11, we see the believers in Heaven worshipping God by falling on their knees and casting their crowns before God. Truly God is worthy of all our praise and worship.
