Message Topic: Doctrine of Justification

Scripture Text: Romans 5: 1-11

1. What is Justification? It is to be made righteous and not stand guilty before God anymore. Justification is the act of God's free grace on the basis of faith alone in Christ alone.

- 2. Sin separates man from God. Man will not seek after God by themselves though they think that by doing good they can go to heaven. The Bible tells us all our good works are filthy rags before God.
