Topic: Soli Deo Gloria

Scripture Text: Psalm 24: 7-10

1. The biblical themes of the reformation are: Scriptures Alone; Grace Alone; Christ Alone; Faith Alone and Glory to God Alone (Soli Deo Gloria). The reformers are all singularly occupied with the glory of God which is their passion and focus in life.

- 2. Our salvation is for the glory of God. We are saved to serve God and to glorify Him.
- 3. The word "Glory" in Hebrews is "Kavab" which means heavy and rich. God's glory is majestic and full of riches. Everything must finally bring glory of God. God is eternal with no beginning and no ending and He is self-existent and self-sufficient. God alone is worthy of all glory.
- 4. We must never rob God of His glory by showing off and serve God with selfish motives and self-glory. We must serve God with a grateful heart to praise Him only.
- 5. We can learn from Moses to be fearless as he is consumed by the glory of God only and destroyed the golden calf that the Israelites made to worship.
