- 1. God is a very present help in times of trouble. He is kind and loving to us. Hence, Jesus said to us in John 14:1 "let not your heart be troubled". Jesus who spoke these words to us is God Himself. That is why Jesus said if the hearers believe in God, they must also believe in Him who is God.
