Topic: What the Bible says of Religions

Scripture Text: 1 Tim 2: 5-7

1. We live in this world where there are no absolutes, even in morality. People claim that there are more than one way to God.

- 2. The Bible declared clearly that there is ONE God only. We worship the Lord Jesus Christ as the true and living God. We are to worship Him the way taught in the Bible. Others may claim that there are many gods that will lead to heaven, but that is not true.
- 3. There is ONE way and ONE mediator. Because of sin, there is no peace between God and man. The only Mediator is Jesus Christ, who became a man himself to save us. He is our representative who paid the price of our sins by dying on the cross. Jesus Christ is ordained and anointed by God the Father himself. On earth, He kept the law perfectly for us. His ransom to die on the cross is paid to God, not to Satan, to save us from our sins.
- 4. Only Jesus saves. Many churches have compromised and fellowship with other religions and accept that all ways lead to God. If we are to be faithful to God, we must not conform to this wrong doctrine.
