Topic: Christians must give thanks

Scripture Text: Psalm 103

1. Thanksgiving Sunday is not confined to one particular Sunday that we are more thankful than other days. 1 Thess 5:18 commands us to give thanks in everything. Hence everyday ought to be a thanksgiving day unto the Lord.
