Topic: He is able

Scripture Text: Ephesians 3:20-21

1. The 2 verses in Eph 3:20-21 is a doxology – a short hymn of praise to God. It is an outburst of praise to God from the heart of the Apostle Paul which is very comforting to every believer as we can see the ability of God at work in our lives and in control of everything.

- 2. How much is God able to work? Verse 20 shows to us the pyramid of God's power at work:
- God is able to do
- God is able to do exceedingly abundantly (i.e. far above)
- God is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask
- God is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we think
- 3. We must learn to ask God beyond material and physical needs. We need to ask God for spiritual blessings according to His will and then it will amaze us to see the power at work beyond what we ask or think.
- 4. How are we to respond to God? Verse 21 tells us we should give all glory to Him. God sustains our church and every ministry in our church so we must always acknowledge and praise Him. The glory of God is forever and it will be world without end.
- 5. The power of God is in every believer through the indwelling of the Holy Spirit. Let our lives manifest the power of God to His glory.
