Topic: A Church in Order - A Glorious Gospel

Scripture text: 1 Timothy 1:12-17

1. The Gospel is the power of God to save all men and it is offered to everyone. The Great Commission for all believers is to preach the Gospel. The Gospel of Jesus Christ is clearly stated in 1 Cor 15:3-4 that Jesus Christ died for our sins, and that He was buried and on the third day, He rose again according to the Scriptures.

Paul said that he is chief of sinners and yet God can save him. This must also be our experience.
4. The Gospel of Jesus Christ is a glorious Gospel because it leads us to praise God. We must never take the Gospel for granted, We thank the Lord Jesus for saving us and He is indeed eternal, immortal, invisible, the only wise God. All glory and honour be to His name only.
