Topic: Who is Jesus to You?

Scripture text: Mark 8:27-30; Matthew 16:13-20

1. The most important question for us is "Who is Jesus to you". With Christianity falling away, it is critical for believers to know God's truth. There are different "versions" of Jesus Christ promoted by different groups such as the Roman Catholics, neo-evangelicals, charismatics and Mormons. We must know the real Jesus Christ and answer correctly. The consequence is eternity in heaven or in hell.
2. The most important answer is that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God. It is not about what other people may say about Jesus but what we believe in. Jesus Christ is far greater than all the prophets. He is the Anointed One, chosen to save the world from sin. He is God Incarnate. He is God Himself. Peter believed in the humanity and deity of Jesus Christ. This answer came from God.
3. The most important foundation we need to have is Jesus Christ. He is the foundation of the church - the universal, invisible church. Trusting in the Jesus Christ of the Bible will give us assurance and security. The foundation is safe and secure. Nothing can take away our salvation. The key of the kingdom of heaven is the Word of God, the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.
4. We must hold on to the gospel of Jesus Christ for our living and for our testimony.
