Topic: A Study of 2 Timothy: Unashamed of Christ

Scripture text: 2 Timothy 1:8-11

1. We are all ambassadors of Christ to witness for Him and to spread the gospel message. As ambassadors, we must be committed to our task and message.

2. We must not be ashamed of Christ. Neither should we be pressurised to reject Christ or fear to acknowledge Him. We must not compromise but present the true gospel. Our attitude will show in how we treat the gospel and how we treat God's servants. We must be prepared to suffer afflictions which are physical and emotional.

3. In order to do so, we must know the power of God. We must depend and rely on God, trusting that His grace will see us through. It is the power of salvation, the power that gives us life and immortality. How can we be ashamed of Christ after knowing what Christ has done. His power can abolish death and can see us through our afflictions.

4. Therefore, we should embrace our calling. We must be faithful and not be ashamed of our appointment. When we fulfill our calling, we will not do anything that will shame the Lord Jesus Christ.
