Topic: Down from His glory

Scripture text: Philippians 2:5-11

1. Christmas is about Christ. It is about how He came down from His glory. Without Him, there is no salvation, no peace and no joy.

2. When Christ came, it was a demonstration of His humility. He is the Second Person of the Trinity. He is 100% God. There is none higher than Him. He is the King of kings and Lord of lords. When He came, He did not give up His divine nature but His external glory. He became 100% man to be a servant in this world, to save sinners from sin. Because all have sinned and come short of the glory of God, all are facing death and judgement. Jesus Christ came down to serve as our Saviour.

3. When Christ came, it was a demonstration of His obedience. This refers to His active and passive obedience. He kept God's laws perfectly for us. He suffered and died in our place. He was obedient to the will of God. When He comes again, He will come as a Judge and everyone will have to submit to Him one day. Because of what He has done, God the Father will exalt Him.
