Topic: Moulding a Man of God
Scripture text: Exodus 2:11-25

1. When we become believers, God gives us spiritual gifts to serve Him. We have different callings and different areas of service. God will mould us and prepare us such that we can fulfil our calling.

2. Moses was not ready to lead the children of Israel out of Egypt yet. Therefore, God had to prepare him. Moses did not forget his roots after growing up in Egypt. He wanted to protect his own people but he was hasty and immature in the faith. He trusted in himself, his own strength and judgement, and took matters into his own hand. He had to flee Egypt and ended up in the land of Midian. He became a shepherd and took care of the sheep in the desert for 40 years.

3. Moses had to learn that he is a nobody and he is just an unworthy servant. God humbled Moses so that he would only trust in God and not himself. Likewise, we must be humble to trust in the LORD and serve Him according to His will. God will mould us by breaking our self-will and then building us up in godliness.
