- 1. Since the coming of the Lord is soon, we must be spiritually sensitive to God's will for our lives. One of such is to be long suffering with others. It is necessary for us now on Earth to provoke one another unto love and good works so that our brethren will be kept away from the path of sin. This is something no longer necessary in Heaven when we have our glorified bodies.
- Christians must first consider one another. Do not be selfish and only think of ourselves and our needs. We should have the desire to help, comfort and bless others. It sometimes means that we have to rebuke others so that they walk in the ways of the Lord.
