Topic: Studies in Exodus: Leaders Stop Leading?

Scripture text: Exodus 6:1-8

1. Leaders often face discouragement when serving the LORD whether in church or at home. Moses faced the temptation to stop leading because of the difficulties and discouragements. The LORD encouraged Moses to continue to lead. Being a leader is a high calling, not dependent on the circumstances or people but dependent on the LORD.

- 2. Firstly, know that it is an opportunity for God to work. We will gain an experiential knowledge of God's power and sovereignty when we trust in the LORD to help us. He is in control no matter what the situation may be.
- 3. Secondly, know that God is faithful. He is the LORD, the faithful covenantal-keeping God. He will prove Himself to be faithful and His promises will be fulfilled. He is true to His Word even after hundreds of years. We often easily forget God's promises but we must remember His Word and rely on Him.
- 4. Thirdly, know that God will bring about victory. God Himself will ensure it. Everything is dependent on the LORD and He must get the glory. We just need to be obedient and faithful in following His will. Be patient, rest in the LORD and leave the results to Him.
