Topic: Am I Your Enemy?
Text: Galatians 4:16-21

1. Christ taught us to love our enemies. Some are God's enemies (Psalm 139:21); we are to hate them with perfect hatred. The Galatian Christians hated Paul, whom they should have counted as a friend. Those who care for our spiritual well-being are not our enemies (v19)!

2. We must be zealously affected for the truth at all times. Love one another in truth. We must be objective. Paul would only speak firmly to the Galatians, perplexing how some behaved. The latter "law" refers to God's Word, whilst the former, ceremonial laws. We must stick to the Word of God. Know who we should count as friends and who as enemies.
