Topic: Studies in Galatians: Do Good to All

Text: Galatians 6:6-10

- 1. 'Good' is that which is pleasing in God's eyes, done out of love for the Lord.
- 2. Do good because God instructed us so (v6). We must communicate in all good things with any godly person who has taught us God's Word. We must honor them by desiring to walk in the same way with the Lord. This is fellowship.
- 3. Do good because there is just retribution and just reward (v7-8). God is not mocked. All will stand before God in the *Bema* judgment. We will receive the consequences of our sin. It should be no surprise then. If we walk in the Spirit, then will we reap the blessings that accompany eternal life (*see Ephesians 1*).
- 4. Do good and do not lose heart (v9-10). Not all the time is good appreciated. Do not be weary even with the many difficulties in doing good to all. Spare no effort to do good unto <u>all</u> men. Doing good starts at home, with God's people, our family in Christ.
